As a nonpartisan organization, the Alliance's policy team actively monitors key issues at all levels of government and is registered to lobby in Wisconsin to represent one thing - the voice of business. Examples of this work include our business education programs such as Schools2Skills[™] and expos, as well as our work surrounding diversity, equity, inclusion and belonging.
